

UMPIRE CHECK LIST

1. Ground Measurements:

- a) Boundary 175 feet or 58.33 yards
- b) Pitch 66 feet or 22 yards (wicket to wicket)
- c) Pitch should be ready by 8:45 AM for morning matches and 1:45 PM for evening matches

2. Toss:

- a) Minimum 8 players from each team should be present to go for toss
- b) Check if all players are from the team roster in Cricclubs
- c) 15 mns before the game start.
- d) Discuss with captains regarding Mankading, ball stuck in fence, ground rules
- e) Catch taken in a declared area is not out.

3. Umpire equipment:

- a) Counter (not stones)
- b) Coin for toss
- c) Proper attire

4. Guard:

- a) It's the umpire duty to check and let the batsman know.
- b) After the initial guard, if the bowler changes his side or arm with out letting the umpire know then it's a no-ball.

5. No-Ball:

- a) When no part of the bowler front foot is behind the popping crease
- b) When no part of the bowler back foot is inside the side crease
- c) Any object falls off from bowler while in run-up or while bowling (Cap, googles, towel, etc.)
- d) Bowler hitting the wickets while in bowling action
- e) Ball bouncing twice before reaching the batter crease
- f) Waist height or above without bouncing
- g) Above shoulder height after bouncing
- 6. **Shorts:** Are <u>NOT allowed</u> as attire on the field of play. This rule is applicable to players and umpires
- 7. **Bails:** Both the captains to discuss if they don't want to use bails and come to a mutual agreement. In case of a 'no-agreement' Neutral Umpire's will take the FINAL call
- Smoking and alcohol consumption are strictly prohibited on any of the school/city grounds. Team members must go outside the ground/school premises to smoke. Umpires to report any violations to the board.
- 9. First ball should be bowled by latest 9.30am and 2.30pm for the matches scheduled at 9am and 2pm respectively. If the match starts after 9:30 am /2:30 pm, then the First ball should be bowled by latest 9:45 am and 2:45 pm for the matches scheduled at 9:00 am and 2:00 pm respectively with the offending team forfeiting the toss, bowling 20 overs and batting 18 overs. If the match does not start by 9:45 am/2:45 pm, the offending team gives a walkover or forfeits the match to the opponents. The offending team loses 2 points from their points table.
- 10. Visiting team arriving later than the pre-announced schedule time (Either at 8.45 AM or 1.45 PM) will lose the privilege to decide pitch and boundary positions.
- **11.** *Byes* are allowed. To prevent controversy, leg-byes will not be allowed.
